1. Airport and Transportation Information

The reference airports include the nearest options (Foggia and Bari) and the major international hubs (Naples and Rome) which are useful for intercontinental flights and connections with layovers.

Transfers from Airports to San Severo

Guests could arrive by lunchtime on November 30th or December 1st, 2025.

- From Foggia Airport (FOG):
 - o **Taxi/Car Rental:** The fastest way (approx. 40 min).
 - **Shuttle + Train:** Shuttle bus from the airport to Foggia Station, then a regional train to San Severo (approx. 15-20 min).
- From Bari Airport (BRI):
 - o **Train:** Shuttle (Metropolitan train or Bus) to **Bari Centrale**. Then an Intercity or Regional train to **San Severo** (1h 30m 2h total).
- From Naples Airport (NAP):
 - o **Bus/Taxi/Shuttle** to **Napoli Centrale**. Then an Intercity or High-Speed Train (to Foggia) and a Regional Train to San Severo.
- From Rome Fiumicino Airport (FCO):
 - o "Leonardo Express" Train to Roma Termini.
 - o High-Speed Train (Frecciarossa/Italo) from Rome to Foggia.
 - o From Foggia, Regional train to San Severo. (Total time from Rome: 3h 30m 4h 30m).

2. Bus / Shuttle Operator Details and Timetables (Updated)

To ensure maximum accuracy, guests are advised to always check the timetables and availability on the official company website close to the travel dates (November/December 2025), as schedules are subject to seasonal or holiday changes.

2.1. From Bari Airport (BRI) to Foggia (or San Severo)

This line is managed as part of the regional **Pugliairbus** service, often operated by local companies on behalf of the Puglia Region. The company most frequently associated with this route is **Metauro Bus**.

- **Metauro Bus / Pugliairbus:** PDF timetable files can often be consulted directly on the Metauro Bus website in the "Pugliairbus" or "Autolinee Regionali" sections.
- Aggregator Sites (e.g., Omio, Busbud): Useful for comparing the timetables of different companies.

2.2. From Rome Fiumicino (FCO) to San Severo (Direct)

For this long-distance route, the main bus companies often offer direct services connecting Rome Airport (or Tiburtina Station) to San Severo.

How to find the PDF or timetables:

- **FlixBus:** Consult the official website by entering "Roma Fiumicino" as the departure and "San Severo" as the destination. Timetables are dynamic and shown at the time of the search.
- Ferrovie del Gargano: Consult the "Autolinee" or "Servizi Interregionali" section on the official website.

2.3. From Naples Airport (NAP) to Foggia or San Severo

Naples Airport is connected to the city center (Stazione Centrale/Metropark), from which interregional bus services depart.

How to find the PDF or timetables:

- FlixBus: Enter "Napoli Aeroporto" or "Napoli" as the departure and "Foggia" or "San Severo" as the destination.
- Air Campania: Consult the "Linee Interregionali" section for the Naples-Foggia line.

4. What to Visit in San Severo - City of Art and Traditions

San Severo, recognized as a City of Art since 2006, offers a rich historical and cultural heritage.

Historical and Cultural Highlights

- The Historic Center (Terre Vecchie): Walk through the narrow streets of the ancient nucleus to discover historic churches and palaces.
- Cathedral of Santa Maria Assunta: An example of Baroque architecture, it houses a precious 12th-century baptismal font.
- Sanctuary of the Madonna del Soccorso (Church of Sant'Agostino): Dedicated to the Patron Saint of the city, it is an important place of worship from the 18th century.
- Church of San Severino Abate: The mother church with the tallest bell tower in the city.
- "Giuseppe Verdi" Municipal Theater: One of Puglia's historic theaters.
- MAT Museum of the Upper Tavoliere: Housed in Palazzo San Francesco, it collects archaeological finds and collections that tell the story of the territory.
- The Underground Cellars (Subterranean Wine Cathedrals): San Severo is the first Apulian city to have obtained the DOC (Controlled Designation of Origin) for its wines. The underground cellars testify to this long wine tradition.

Characteristics and Traditions

- San Severo DOC Wine: The city is renowned for the production of fine wines, particularly Nero di Troia. Wine tastings can be organized.
- Architecture: The city is distinguished by its monumental buildings of a particular reddish color, earning it the nickname "City of Bell Towers".
