



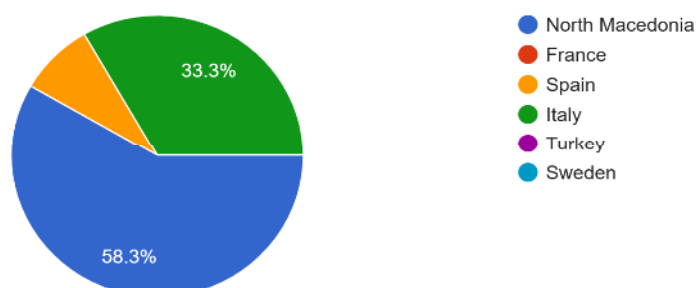

The 58,3% of the demanders are from North Macedonia, the 33,3% are from Italy and the 8,3% from Spain.

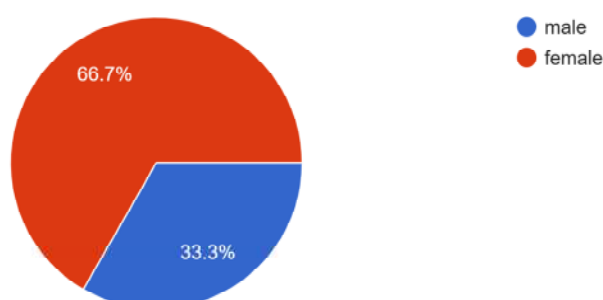

The 66,7% of the demanders are males, the 33,3% are females.

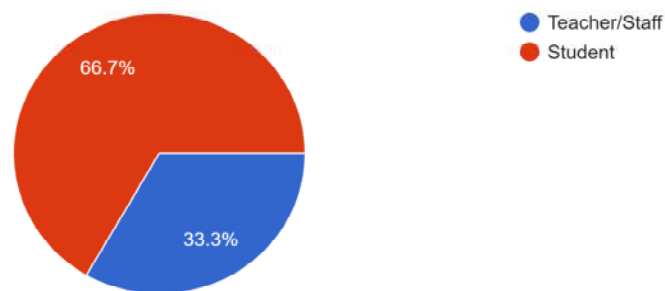

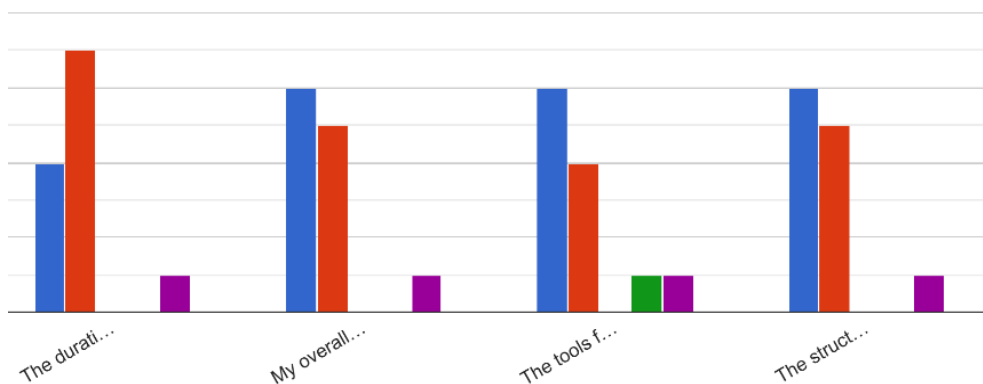
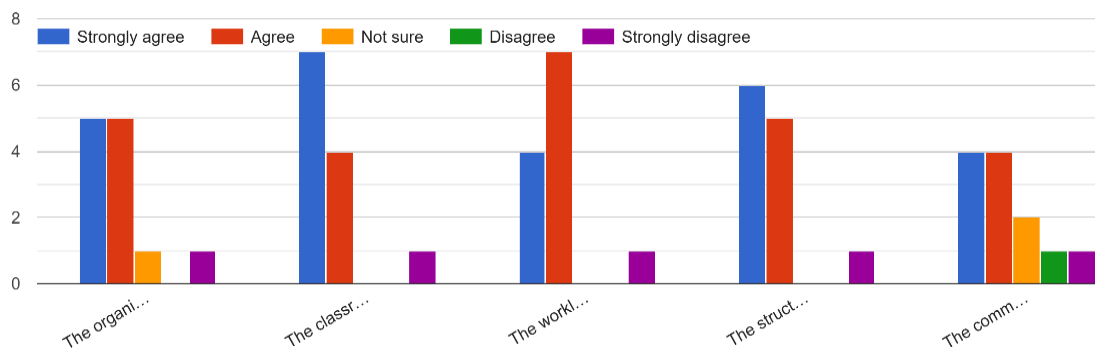
Do you think your perception on using the new Knowledge in classroom has changed after this LTTA?

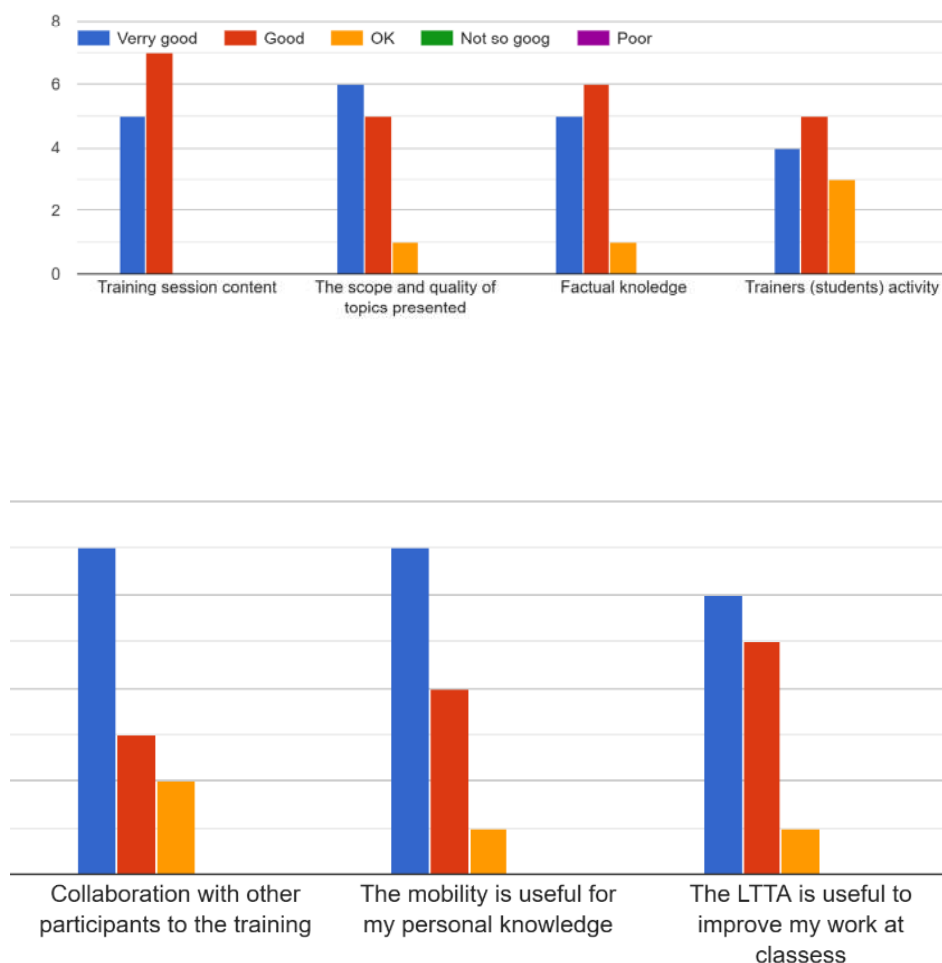
