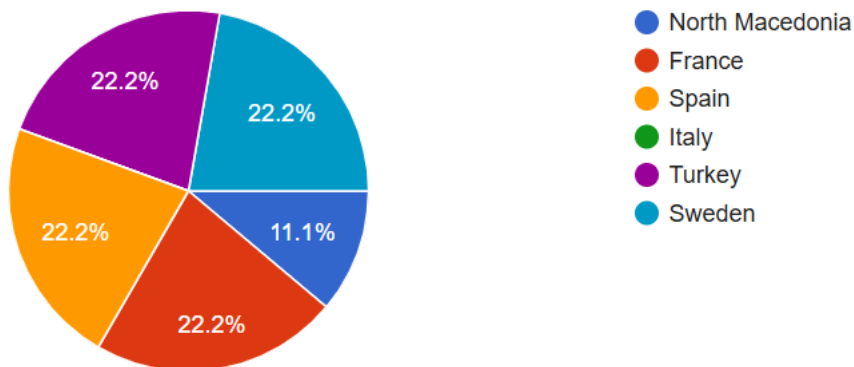


## RESUME – WP3 - A4 - TPM2 Activity I – EcoEdu -- Italy

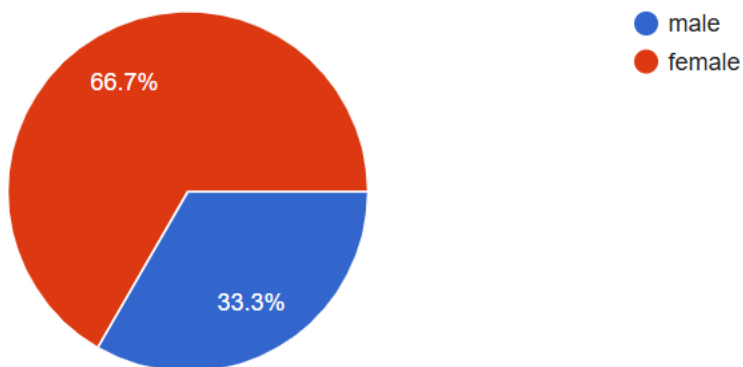
### 1. You are from

**4. On a scale from 1 to 5 how likely are you to use the information taught in this LTTA in the future, in classes?**

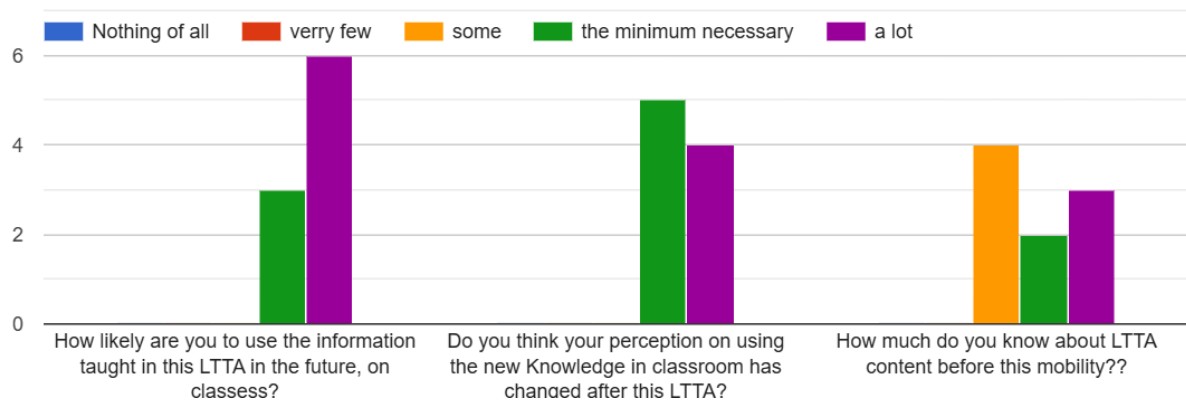
6 participants said that they would use the information “a lot”, and 3 said that they would use it “the minimum necessary.”

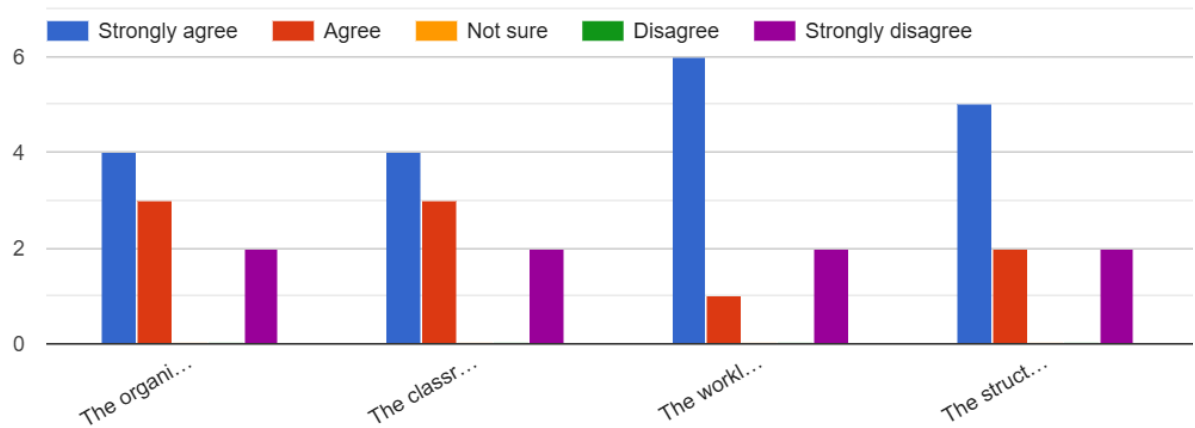
4 participants strongly agreed, 3 agreed, and 2 strongly disagreed.

2 participants strongly agreed, 5 agreed, and 2 strongly disagreed.

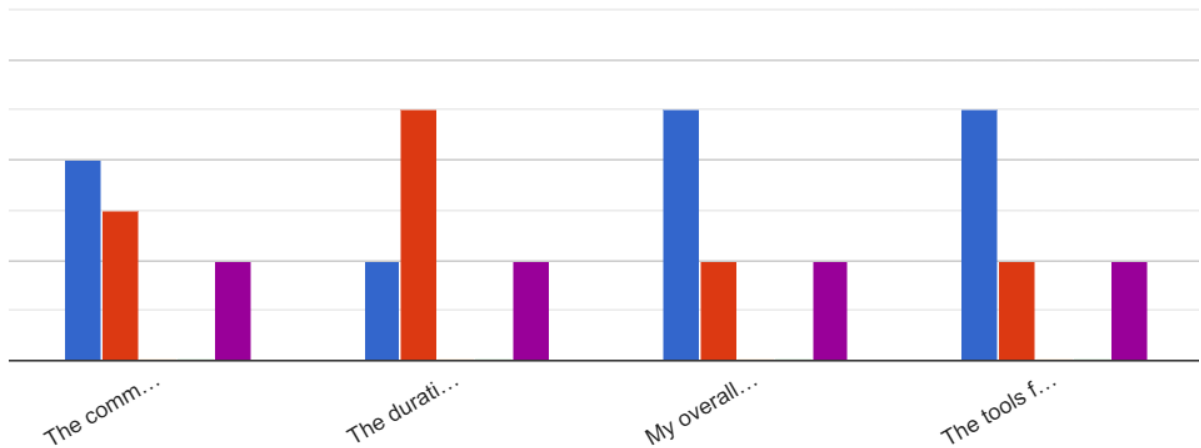

- 14. Please select the appropriate answer from ‘strongly agree’ to ‘strongly disagree’ on the following statement: The tools for**

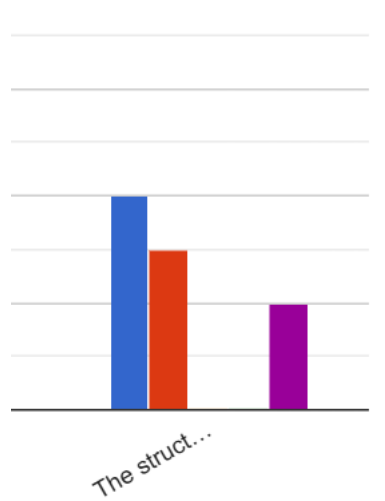
**communication between the participants were effective and easy to use**

5 participants strongly agreed, 2 agreed, and 2 strongly disagreed.



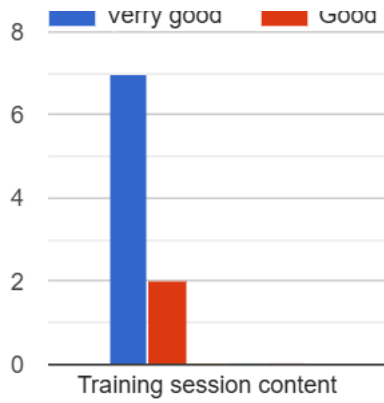

4 participants strongly agreed, 3 agreed, and 2 strongly disagreed.



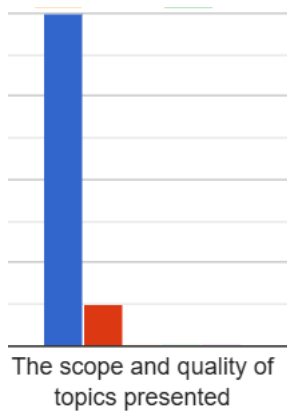
**16. Please rate the quality of the training session content from ‘very good’ to ‘poor.’**

7 participants said, ‘very good’ and 2 said ‘good.’



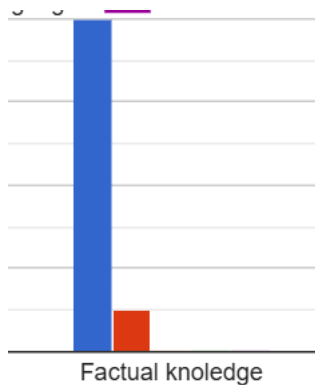
**17. Please rate the scope and quality of the topics presented from 'very good' to 'poor.'**

8 participants said, 'very good' and 1 said 'good.'



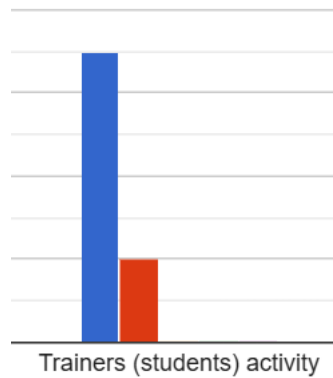
**18. Please rate the factual knowledge from 'very good' to 'poor.'**

8 participants said, 'very good' and 1 said 'good.'



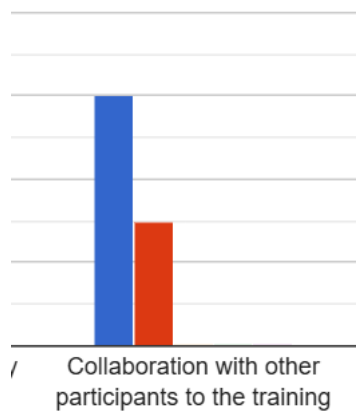
**19. Please rate the trainers (students) activity from 'very good' to 'poor.'**

7 participants said, 'very good' and 2 said 'good.'



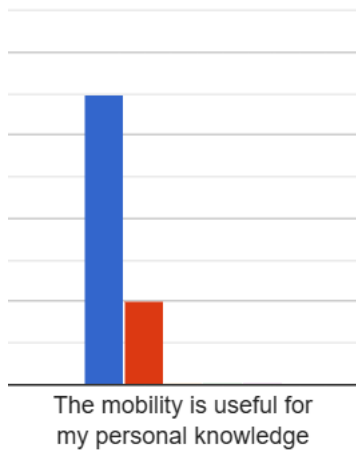
**20. Please rate the collaboration with the other participants to the training from 'very good' to 'poor.'**

6 participants said, 'very good' and 3 said 'good.'



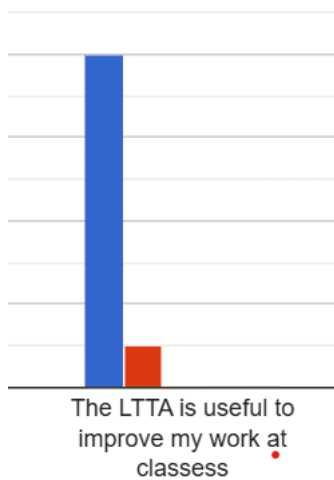
**21. Please rate how useful the mobility is for your personal knowledge from 'very good' to 'poor.'**

**23. The best part of the mobility was:**

Many participants praised the organization of the mobility and its clear leadership. They also enjoyed meeting other educators and exchanging opinions. The group and the activity was said to have a "positive energy."

**24. The worst part of the mobility was:**

Most participants had no comments in this section, except for two people mentioning the poor weather conditions.

**25. What are unexpected benefits or positive aspects of taking part in this mobility?**

Participants mentioned the benefits of the mobility as a networking event, and a way to experience the points of view of others. Some mentioned enjoying the opportunity to build their knowledge and creativity, refreshing their teaching. One participant enjoyed seeing the progression of the project.

**26. How do you think that this mobility could be improved?**

There was no constructive criticism given by participants.

**27. Other remarks you have:**

Participants stated that they enjoyed and would recommend the course. One requested “more days to make activities in mobilities.”

**28. Recommendation for the future mobilities?**

Most participants had no comments to share, but one requested that more days be added to the mobility.

**29. A final remark for the coordinator of the host school, please**

Participants shared their thanks, called the mobility “superb,” and one praised the coordinator’s “professional approach,” as “the participants felt supported, informed and motivated throughout the mobility.”

**30. Describe in a sentence the general idea that you will bring with you, going back to your school.**

The participants described feeling a renewed sense of motivation, in particular towards sustainability. “New ideas” have been generated by the mobility.
